We see the truth of this verse lived out around us on a daily basis here in Cambodia! The enemy has kept Cambodia in darkness for thousands of years. As we have been sharing the Gospel message here in Cambodia, we are seeing the way in which people are blinded and live in darkness. In the Buddhist worldview, sin affects only the individual and their future reincarnation. Furthermore, there is no belief in a personal God who created each individual. In this worldview, when one sins, he is has not sinned against God and is therefore not personally accountable nor responsible to God for their sin. We continue to meet with different people to conduct Bible studies. I do a discipleship Bible Study with two adult Christians and one Salvation study with a teenage boy named Pe-sut. A classmate of his was recently murdered and this has led Pe-sut to consider his own death one day. **Please pray for Pe-sut to be saved.** Naomi is also doing a Salvation Bible study with a young teenaged girl named Pe-say. She is a simple girl who is slow to understand new concepts. **Please pray for Pe-say to understand the Gospel and be saved.** As part of the discipleship Bible studies, I am going through I Corinthians 8-10. In these chapters, Paul addresses the issue of eating meat offered to idols. This is a very important truth that is directly applicable to the culture in Cambodia.

We are looking forward to special Christmas activities that we have planned with the church here and with the children's Bible club. Christmas is celebrated in the capitol of Phnom Penh but has yet to become a big holiday in the provinces. **Please pray** for open doors to witness as we share Christmas cookies and tracts with neighbors.
