We don't yet understand every aspect of the Cambodian culture or language. Daily we are confronted with our lack of understanding and are driven to dependence on God.

The Cambodian belief system is one area in which we are continually trying to gain more understanding. Though Cambodia is 95% Buddhist, the Buddhism they practice on a daily basis is very different from what you will read in a comparative religions book. In all our time here, we have never met anyone who could give a coherent explanation of their belief system. This changed last Friday when we went to go visit a national pastor named Tho. Tho was saved and called to preach under my dad's ministry. He is now starting a church in his home village. Before his salvation, Tho had been a monk for nearly 5 years. Through the course of our visit, Tho was able to give us a clear explanation of some of the core beliefs of Cambodian Buddhism. So many things began to make more sense in our minds! We now have a clearer idea of the issues that need to be confronted by Biblical teachings. We thank God for how he directs our paths and uses others around us to help us grow!
