An insight into Buddhism

This morning we were once again reminded of the spiritual bondage that grips Cambodia. In Buddhism, it is considered a sin, or demerit, to kill an animal. This has always confused us since people eat meat and even raise animals for meat at their property. As I was discussing this with another Cambodian Christian named Nan, she told me that one of our neighbors won't kill a chicken because she is afraid of incurring sin/demerit. Instead, she has her own children kill the chickens for meals. "Doesn't that mean that her children will be sinning?" I asked. "Yes," Nan replied, "but they are still young." Upon seeing my confusion Nan said, "Your neighbor is getting old and doesn't want to incur too much sin before she dies. She is so scared to die!" Our hearts break for the millions of Cambodians "who through fear of death" are in bondage. (Heb. 2:15)

It has been a busy season for us these past two months. In May we attended the Pressing Forward Conference at New Hope Baptist Church in Phnom Penh.
